Editorial Procedure:

1. Editors accept texts stored in a text file made in MS Word, which are submitted via the website: <http://pwp.edu.pl/> (link: "Submit your article") or emailed to: pwp@pwp.edu.pl.
2. The manuscript sent for publication in the section "articles" should contain summaries in English (up to 300 characters with spaces), keywords in Polish language (up to 6 words) and keywords in the English language (up to 6 words). The maximum volume of the submitted work may not exceed one publishing sheet (about 22 pages of the manuscript, 1800 characters per page including spaces).
3. The text should comply with all the requirements set out on the website (section "for authors")
4. The text shall be accompanied by a brief written information about the author of the article.
5. The editorial Office reserves the right to make the following corrections in the texts of articles: changes of titles, addition of sub-headings, abbreviations, technical alterations and styling and linguistic corrections.
6. The editor does not return unsolicited articles.
